The "Images of America" series by Arcadia Publishing started in 1990 as a way for communities across the United States to preserve and share their history.

"From Samuel To Ruby" was the caption on a recent article by Edow, Jim Cooper, in the Roane Co. newspaper, The Times Record, describing the new book in this series "Roane County" sponsored by the Roane County Historical Society. The 204 photographs contained in the book, authored by Anna Tannery, cover 150 years from Samuel Tannery's wife Anna Ruby Bradley's heritage and of the decades after. Anna Tannery became Spencer's first settler in 1812, and Bradley, a Roane native who died in 2002, was
