**Samuel F. Webb**

Last rites for Samuel F. Webb, 65 years old father of Mrs. Letha Coe of Spencer, died last Tuesday at the home of his son. Foster Webb of Wickliffe, O., where he had been visiting for two weeks, were held Saturday at 3:30 p.m. at the Rockland Methodist Church with the Rev. L. C. Rucker officiating. Burial was in the Rockland Cemetery.

A son of the late Jonas and Elizabeth Webb, he was born in Roane County but for the last 14 years had resided in vicinity of Belpre, O. He was stricken suddenly while at his son's home.
